Who am I?

Why me?

I was LGBT Officer 2019-2020 and Welfare Officer 2021-2022 so I have experience listening to students' concerns and communicating them to staff members.

I want to make sure that things are as straightforward for students as possible and facilitate conversations between students and staff to make sure your concerns are heard.

Policies

- **Transparency and Communication** - Keep students fully informed and involved with college decisions
- **Catering** - Liaise with the HUS Services Officer to make sure that hall food is suitable for everyone regardless of allergies or religious requirements.
- **U Bus** - Continue working with the HUS VPX and Girton JCR to lobby the university to return the U bus service to Homerton in full.
- **Welfare** - Continue the focus on welfare and provide peer support training to HUS Committee members and others who register interest. Also collaborate with the Cam SU Welfare officer and HUS VPX to offer counselling to college welfare officers.
- **Sabbatical roles** - Propose a change to the HUS constitution so that there is always a paid sabbatical role, regardless of whether JCR president is undertaken as a sabbatical role. For instance, if the president is a current student, the funding allocated to a sabbatical president could instead be allocated to a sabbatical welfare officer - ensuring there is always at least one staff member dedicated to representing students.
